INNOVATIVE DESIGN

We've always been inspired by art and artists of all kinds and backgrounds. For the UBAC range we looked at the work of Gunta Stolzl and her tapestry. We loved the way she was able to tell a story with shapes and colors.

This year we wanted to try something new, drawing a panoramic landscape and telling our own story. Drawing inspiration from our DNA, we used a part a our logo to draw the paths with curved or straight lines, mellow or steep mountains but always sharing your line with others. Our skis are designed for adventures - from mellow hills and mountain passes to sharper and steeper peaks, we've created our own mountain chain.

Last year, we worked with a new artist to design the SLAP 104 Lite. Listening to your feedback, we kept the flow going with Tommy Knuts to design the new SLAP range for this year.

The result is something unique. A diptych mixing abstract shapes with mountains, snow, trees and whatever your mind can imagine. Bringing back ZAG roots with illustrations but twisting it with our color block DNA.

ADVANCED TECHNOLOGY

Our two engineers Bastien Saillard and Paul Chevalot design our skis in the ZAG Lab located in Chamonix with the goal of satisfying the many tastes of our customers. Always hungry to improve, they spend their time studying innovative shapes, materials, and constructions.

"We are compelled to endlessly innovate by creating skis that are increasingly intuitive, comfortable, high performing, and that provide skiers with a unique riding experience. With our concept store at the foot of Grands Montets, our playground is in our backyard. Being so connected with the environment is a true source of inspiration.

This is what allows us to create such comfortable and high-performing skis."

The ZAG LAB allows our engineers to create prototypes in record time, and its prime location in Chamonix lets us test them right away and make improvements accordingly. The team was able to test the skis on all types of snow.

This year, they developped the MATA, a new all-mountain ski that allows unique carving sensations.

This connection to nature pushes ZAG's R&D team to create products that are respectful to the environment, especially through the use of new materials or designs. The ZAGREEN Program represents ZAG's commitment to sustainability.



Aware that our playground is threatened and that the quality of the air in the valley is more and more an issue of discussion, ZAG has launched the ZAGreen Program. Created in 2017, the aim of this program is to reduce the environmental impact of the ski industry. The actions that will be done will concern the manufacturing of the products, the way we practice skiing and also the daily life in our office. In addition to the measures involving only the company, the aim is to increase awareness among the whole community about the environmental challenge that is the air quality in our valley. ZAGreen is a project that hopes to be heard and also to involve more actors of this beautiful place.

All of our materials and products are developped in collaboration with our suppliers to reduce the impact while keeping the performance, quality and durability of our skis unchanged.

For example, our thermoplastics are made from recycled materials and produced in a responsible way (REACH, reductions of waste,...).

The enrolment of the ski-touring line in the project 1% for the planet also helps ZAG reaching its goal : preserving its playground. In 2021, ZAG redistributed this percentage to Mountain Wilderness. In 2023, we are giving the 1% to Mountain Riders and the cleaning project «Adopt ton spot», in Chamonix (La Flégère).



BIO SOURCED RESIN

We have used a resin which is 33% bio-sourced to produce the ADRET range since 2016. 25 % for the other range. It is mainly composed of oil produced with oil plants.
